-If you see a neighbor on the map or recognize an address, please forward this email it to them or call them and tell them to go to <u>www.cityofhunterscreek.com</u> and <u>REGISTER TO</u> <u>RECEIVE COMMUNITY ALERTS.</u> This is a critical time for us to get as much of the critical, credible information out to as many residents as possible, so please help out in this effort. -After this push for sign-ups, we're considering mobilizing a student army to go door to door and sign those up who aren't. The kids are probably driving you nuts anyway and it would get them out of the house. (more info to follow later)

-Please support our local restaurants via Take out or delivery through this difficult time. We're working on another food option that will be huge for our Village (hopefully, more info to follow soon).

-Garbage and Recycling pick-up will continue as usual. Please bag all garbage and remember to rinse all recyclable items before placing them in the recycling bin.

-Earlier this week, our Memorial Village Police Chief sent out a registry for Seniors and Special Needs Residents. Please make sure anyone you know in Hunters Creek signs up for such, if needed. It also includes a daily *"Welfare Call"* for those who might need it. This is huge. NO ONE else does this and is why we have the best Police Dept. in the Nation.
