SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL AGENDA

Notice is hereby given that on the 22nd day of May, 2024, the governing body of the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas will hold an Emergency city council meeting to be held at 5:00 p.m. at the City Hall located at 1 Hunters Creek Place, Houston, Texas 77024, Texas, for the purpose of considering the following agenda items. All agenda items are subject to action. The city council reserves the right to meet in a closed session on any agenda item should the need arise and if applicable pursuant to authorization by title 5, chapter 551, of the Texas government code.

Pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.045, the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas, City Council will convene in an Emergency Meeting based on an imminent threat to public health and safety, namely a severe weather event (Derecho). The Federal Government Declared a Disaster for Harris County, Texas. Hunters Creek Mayor Declared a Disaster for the City under Texas Government Code, Chapter 418, and this meeting is held in conformance with Texas Government Code, Chapter 418, including but not limited to Section 418.1102.

CITY COUNCIL MEMBER(S) MAY ATTEND THIS EMERGENCY MEETING VIA TELEPHONE AS ALLOWED BY TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, SECTION 551.125. AN EMERGENCY OR PUBLIC NECESSITY EXISTS WITHIN THE MEANING OF TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, SECTION 551.045; AND (2) THE CONVENING AT ONE LOCATION OF A QUORUM OF THE GOVERNMENTAL BODY IS DIFFICULT OR IMPOSSIBLE.


- A. Call to order and the roll of elected and appointed officers will be taken.
- B. **PUBLIC COMMENTS** *At this time, any person with city-related business may speak to the Council. In compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, if a member of the public comments or inquires about a subject that is not specifically identified on the agenda, a member of council or a staff member may only respond by giving a statement of specific factual information or by reciting existing policy. The City Council may not deliberate or vote on the matter.*
- C. **REGULAR AGENDA**
 - 1. Discussion and possible action to approve an Ordinance extending the Disaster Declaration for severe weather event.

D. ADJOURNMENT

The City Council may convene a public meeting and then recess into closed executive session, to discuss any of the items listed on this agenda, if necessary, and if authorized under chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code. Situations in which a closed executive session may be authorized by law include, without limitation; (1) consulting with the Council's attorney to seek or receive legal advice concerning pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, or any other matter in which the ethical duty of the attorney to the Council clearly conflicts with the general requirement that all meetings be open, § 551.071; (2) discussing the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property, § 551.072; (3) discussing a prospective gift or donation, § 551.073; (4) discussing certain personnel matters, §551.074; and (5) discussing security personnel or devices, § 551.076.
