Declaration of Disaster

WHEREAS, the City of Hunters Creek, Village, Texas, on the 16th day of May, 2024, suffered widespread of severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from high winds and water; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE. TEXAS:

- 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas, based on §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Hunters Creek Village.
- 3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
- 4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.
- 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
