

## TEMPORARY CURFEW ORDER

**WHEREAS**, on July 8<sup>th</sup> 2024, I, Jim Pappas, the Mayor of the City Hunters Creek Village, Harris County, Texas (the "City"), exercised my authority under Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code to declare a local state of disaster for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the imposition of a temporary curfew is necessary to protect public health and safety and to protect property from damage or destruction during this state of local disaster;

### **FOR THE REASONS STATED, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** It shall be unlawful for any person to remain on, or travel upon, any public street, road, sidewalk or other public property in the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas, between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during the duration of this order.

**Section 2.** The restrictions contained in Section 1, above, shall not apply to police officers, fire fighters or any other persons authorized by local, state or federal governmental officials to assist in protecting public health and safety.

**Section 3.** I hereby authorize the Memorial Villages Police Department to enforce this order.

**Section 4.** The regulations contained in this order shall remain in effect from July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024, until July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2024, or until further action by me, whichever occurs first.

**Section 5.** I hereby direct City staff to take steps to notify the public of this order and see that it is given prompt and general publicity and to see that the City Secretary promptly files the original of this Order in the City's official records.
