

**ORDER DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER  
IN THE CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE, TEXAS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hunters Creek Village, Harris County, Texas (the "City") has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from the effects of inclement weather, being Hurricane Beryl; and

**WHEREAS**, as Mayor of the City (the "Mayor"), I am the presiding officer of the City Council, which is the governing body of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, as Mayor, I have authority, under Section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code, to declare a local state of disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, acting in my official capacity as Mayor, I have determined that a state of disaster exists within the boundaries of the City that requires extraordinary measures to be taken to respond to the effects of inclement weather;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Mayor, make and enter the following Order:

**Section 1.** The facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this Order are true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

**Section 2.** I find and declare that a local state of disaster, as defined in Section 418.004 of the Texas Government Code, exists within the City.

**Section 3.** This Order and my declaration of a local state of disaster shall remain in full force and effect for seven days, unless continued or renewed by the City Council.

**Section 4.** I hereby direct City staff to take steps to notify the public of this order and see that it is given prompt and general publicity and to see that the City Secretary promptly files the original of this Order in the City's official records.

**Section 5.** This Order activates the City's emergency management plan as provided in Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code.

**Section 6.** This Order shall take effect immediately.
