A tax rate of \$0.205164 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of City of Hunters Creek Village.

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2024 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for City of Hunters Creek Village from the same properties in both the 2023 tax year and the 2024 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that City of Hunters Creek Village may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that City of Hunters Creek Village is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2024 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 24, 2024 AT 6:00 PM AT 1 Hunters Creek Pl., Houston, TX 77024.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, City of Hunters Creek Village is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the of City of Hunters Creek Village at their offices or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

Follow-up on Previous Month Items/Requests from Commission

• A formal after-action report was prepared on the recent storms for the cities. <u>Personnel Changes/Issues/Updates</u>

• The Department remains fully staffed.

Major/Significant Events

- Officers initiated the Annual "Back-to-School" Traffic safety plan at all area schools for the new school year.
- Staff met with officials from Memorial Drive Elementary School pre-student return. Due to the parent drop-off drive moving to the east side of the campus, MVPD recommended that no parking be allowed on Smithdale during school hours. MVPD placed temporary signs for the first 2 weeks and traffic moved smoothly through the area. The city has agreed to place permanent signs at the identified locations.
- 8/6/24 600 Block of Voss Road. Officers initiated a traffic stop after observing a traffic violation. A search of the vehicle located several loaded firearms (loaded AK-47 with a drum magazine), masks and rope. A check of the driver's criminal record found the male to be a convicted felon for prior armed robberies. The male was arrested by officers.
- 8/15/24 2000 Block of S. Piney Point Road. Major single vehicle accident involving a motorcycle. Life Flight of the victim. Due to massive head trauma, we were assisted by the HPD accident investigation team.
- 8/30/24 Officers arrested a male suspect who was driving a stolen car. Inside of the vehicle officers located several master mailbox keys along with a jig to produce additional mailbox keys, blank checks, social security cards, multiple stolen license plates and over 150 pieces of mail.

Status Update on Major Projects

• The department administrative team met with IOSO staff and reviewed the QBR and the 2024 POE switch installation project. Work is scheduled to begin in October. <u>Community Projects</u>

Officers attended the annual "Back to School" Ice Cream Social at Hedwig Park.

- MVPD officers were present at all of our village schools during the first 2 weeks of school ensuring that all vehicles were observing the school zones and neighborhood parking regulations.
- MVPD dispatch personnel coordinated the creation of a final list of homes with tree debris still remaining and needing to be picked up. The list was provided to county and city officials.

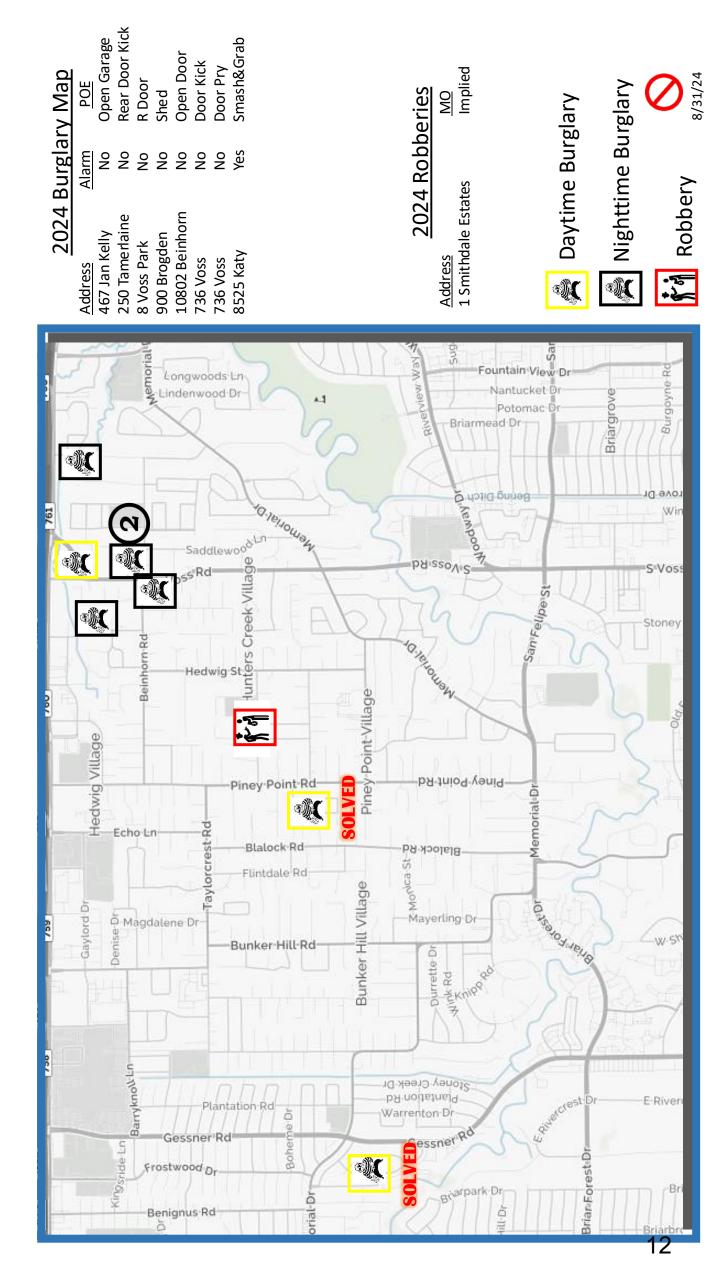

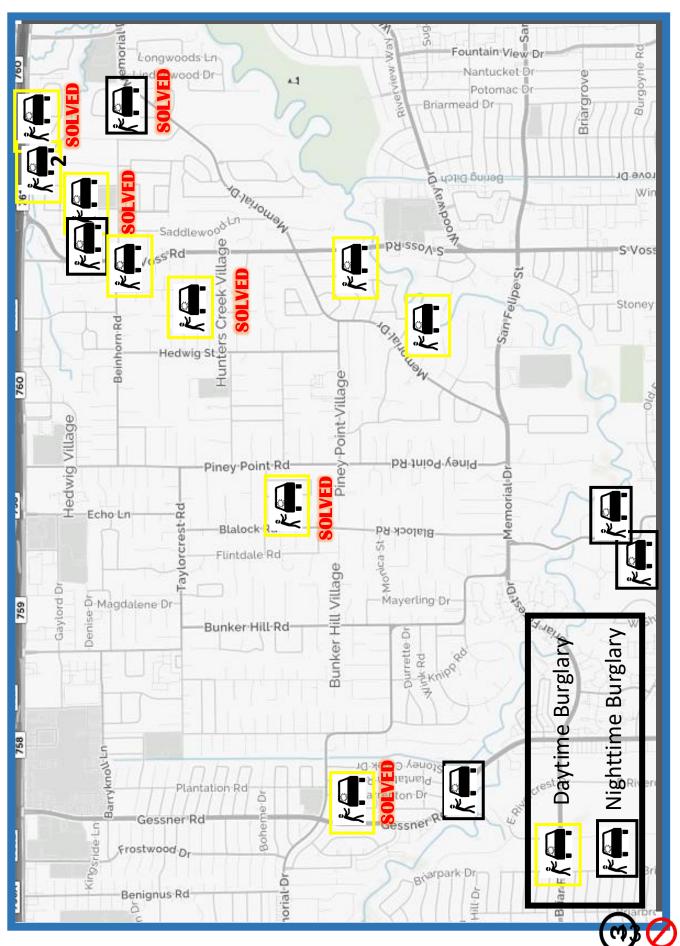
2024 Auto Burglary Map

## CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE ENGINEER'S REPORT

Prepared September 19, 2024 for the September 24th agenda

### A. Shasta/Pineland/Lindenwood Reconstruction

- 1. Town hall was held on September 11<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30. It was attended with approximately 15 residents. The meeting went well along with the intended plan.
- 2. We are currently waiting for bonds from the contractor but expect construction start within 2 weeks.
- 3. We have a 6 month total contract time but expect the neighborhood work to be done within about 4 months.
- 4. Memorial patch work will be completed as part of this project.

## **B.** Minor improvements

- 1. There are two minor drainage improvements that need to be made.
- 2. Thamer Circle inlets: several inlets need to be reconstructed and upsized near 407 Thamer Circle. Cost should be around \$15k or less.
- 3. Melody Lane ditch work: there is virtually no drainage on the north side of Melody Lane which is a dead end. The ditch there is very flat. We could add a pipe where the ditch is and go as steep as necessary to achieve adequate drainage to the west end of the neighborhood for \$10k or less.

## C. 2024 MS4

- 1. We brought this engineering proposal amendment last month with different terms and conditions to the contract than we already have in place by mistake. We have removed those terms and conditions and propose the same scope of work utilizing existing contract language.
- 2. This work is not optional. It is related to the Clean Water Act and subsequent NPDES (non point discharge elimination system) laws.
- 3. This is a once every five year plan that needs prepared to follow the state NPDES permit.
- 4. Basically we need to plan elements and work flows with measurable deliverables to eliminate non-point water related pollutions for the next five years. With annual reporting.

## D. Shasta/Pineland/Lindenwood construction phase services

1. We have an agenda item which is an engineering proposal amendment, number 077. This work covers, construction management, inspection and includes construction materials testing from a geotechnical engineering firm subcontractor.

- 2. This is hourly, not to exceed work assuming 3 days per week, 5 hours per visit for inspection. Additionally, this includes construction management and construction administration. For a total of \$73k.
- 3. We also have engaged Earth Engineering for construction materials testing. Their original proposal was \$72k to meet the requirements of the specifications. We reduced the number of tests by two-thirds to get it down to \$32k.
- 4. This will cover all construction phase services for a total of \$109k.

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE, TEXAS, BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2025, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2025; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY FOR SUCH YEAR AS REFLECTED IN THE BUDGET; MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, on the 23rd day of July 2024, the Mayor filed with the City Secretary a proposed budget containing estimates of revenues for the year from all the various sources, together with estimated costs thereof, and estimated amounts of all other proposed expenditures for the City of Hunters Creek Village for the calendar year 2025, which is also the City's fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a motion of the City Council and after notice was published in the Memorial Examiner on August 7th, 2024, as required by law, a public hearing on the budget was held at the regular meeting place of the City Council at the City of Hunters Creek Village City Hall, # 1 Hunters Creek Place, Houston, Texas, on the 27th of August 2024, at which all citizens and taxpayers of the City had the right to be present and to be heard and those who requested to be heard were heard; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Mayor's proposed budget and the input from the public that it received during the public hearing and has made such changes to the proposed budget as in the City Council's judgment were warranted by law and were in the best interest of the citizens and taxpayers of the City; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed budget, with the changes proposed by the City Council, has been filed with the City Secretary and the City Council now desires to approve and adopt the budget. Now therefore,

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

**Section 2.** The City Council hereby approves and adopts the budget that is attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit "A" as the City's official budget for the City's fiscal year beginning January 1, 2025, and ending December 31, 2025.

**Section 3.** The City Council hereby approves the several sums specified for the several purposes named in the budget, and appropriates those funds to and for the purposes listed in the budget, provided however, that the Mayor is authorized to transfer funds to and from specific projects within Departmental Funds so long as the total revenues and expenditures of such Departmental Funds remain unchanged.

**Section 4.** The City Secretary of the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas, shall file a copy of this Ordinance and attached budget with the County Clerk of Harris County, Texas, and shall maintain the original in the City's official records and on the City's official website as provided in sections 102.008 and 102.011 of the Texas Local Gov't Code.

### ORDINANCE NO. 2024-

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT, LEVY AND COLLECTION OF AD VALOREM TAXES BY THE CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 2024; PROVIDING THE DATE ON WHICH SUCH TAXES SHALL BE DUE AND PAYABLE; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST ON ALL TAXES NOT TIMELY PAID; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE POSTING OF REQUIRED NOTICES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, Section 26.05 of the Texas Tax Code provides that before the later of September 30th, or the 60th day after the date the certified appraisal roll is received by the taxing unit, the governing body of each taxing unit shall adopt a tax rate for the current tax year; and

WHEREAS, such Section further provides that where the tax rate consists of two components (one which will impose the amount of taxes needed to pay the City's debt service and the other which will impose the amount of taxes needed to fund maintenance and operations expenditures of the City for the next fiscal year), each of such two components must be approved separately; and

WHEREAS, having thus separately approved the tax rate for each of such components, it is necessary and appropriate to now formally pass, approve and adopt a 2024 tax rate for the City as set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the proposed tax rate for the current year for the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas consists of two such components, a tax rate of zero (\$0.00) for debt service and a tax rate of \$0.205164 to fund maintenance and operations expenditures of the City for the next fiscal year; and WHEREAS, all actions have been taken, notices given, and hearings held, as required by law as a prerequisite to the passage, approval, and adoption of this tax rate ordinance. Now, therefore,

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUNTERS CREEK VILLAGE, TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted, ratified, and confirmed.

Section 2. Tax levy. There is hereby levied, for the tax year 2024, to fund the City's fiscal year 2025 municipal budget, and for each year thereafter until otherwise provided, an ad valorem tax at the rate of \$0.205164 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation on all property, real, personal, and mixed, within the corporate limits upon which an ad valorem tax is authorized by law to be levied by the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

All such taxes shall be assessed and collected in current money of the United States of America.

Section 3. Uses of taxes levied. Of the total tax levied in Section 2 hereof, \$0.205164 is levied to fund maintenance and operations expenditures of the City for the fiscal year 2025. Of the total tax levied in Section 2 hereof, \$0.00 is levied for the purpose of paying the interest on bonds, warrants, certificates of obligation, or other lawfully authorized evidence of indebtedness issued by the City of Hunters Creek Village Texas, including the various installments of principal due on the serial bonds, warrants, certificates of obligation, or other lawfully authorized evidence of indebtedness issued by the City as such installments shall respectively mature, in the fiscal year 2025.

Section 4. Due date, penalties, and interest. All ad valorem taxes levied hereby, in the total amount of \$0.205164 on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100) of assessed valuation as reflected by Sections 2 and 3 hereof, shall be due and payable on or before January 31, 2025. All ad valorem taxes due to the City of Hunters Creek Village, Texas, and not paid on or before January 31 following the year for which they were levied shall bear penalty and interest as prescribed in the Property Tax Code of the State of Texas.

**Section 5.** Notices. The City Administrator is authorized and directed: a) to provide the information to Harris County required by Section 26.16 of the Texas Tax Code; and b) to post the notices and tax rate and budget information on the City's website required by Sections 26.05(b)(2) and 26.18 of the Texas Tax Code.

**Section 6. Repeal.** All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**Section 7. Severability.** If any provision of this Ordinance is found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other provision of this Ordinance.
