Got that fixed, they deleted several stops they wanted to do and made the existing ones the correct size, and finally got them finished, and they look great.

They will be grading and sodding around the new work they did; they just need some rain for the sod to take hold. No, there won't be shelters or benches.

-Along comes Centerpoint with their new power poles all over the hood. This is part of the new "Grid Resiliency" program after the last hurricanes in beefing up the system to avoid outages, or at a minimum, make them easier to repair. No, I'm not a power expert, but this is what we were told. The poles are in the right-of-way or utility easement, so they have the right to do what they want. They will also be doing tree trimming where needed to keep the lines clear.

Memorial Drive will be closed to one lane with flagmen directing traffic for a few weeks while they replace poles on the north side. Joggers, walkers, dog walkers, and vagrants will be moved to the south sidewalk to avoid potential danger, so please adhere to their direction.

Work is being done all over the Villages, and they're doing their best to minimize disruption to our residents. We want the power to be as reliable as possible, and upgrades to the grid in our area are being done both with poles and new, heavier wire...not an easy task. They will be working 7 days a week to get this done as fast as possible.
