

Arbor Day 2010



Celebrate Arbor Day 2010 by planting a new tree (or several new trees) at your home. Once again, the City of Hunters Creek Village, is proud to sponsor planting new trees within our Village as part of the continuing effort to maintain and restore the ambiance and benefits of our forest-like environment as an integral part of our Arbor Day celebration.

Last year Hurricane Ike took a tremendous toll on the trees through out the Villages. Arborists have opined that over half of the tree canopy was lost as a result of the storm. Nearly, every home in Hunters Creek had damage to its trees. After Ike, the City and residents responded by planting over two hundred new trees. While this was a start to replace the trees destroyed by Ike and other causes, we need to continue the replanting effort this year---and in coming years.

Again this year, Bill Bounds Nursery has made tree planting easy for all residents. At the reasonable price (same as before) of \$120.00, Bill Bounds will plant a 15 gallon tree of your choice selected from the list on the Order Form in your yard and guarantee the tree(s) for a year. If you prefer to plant your new tree(s) yourself, the cost is only \$74.00 per tree. Planting instructions will be provided when your tree(s) is delivered. Planting and delivery, depending on the weather, is planned for February 2010.

Residents are encouraged to plant new trees at their homes. Working together, we can restore and maintain the trademark treed environment that makes our neighborhood unique and attractive. If you want to participate, but do not have a place for a new tree, please send your check to the City with a note to that effect and a tree will be planted in Hunters Creek on your behalf.

Please turn in your completed Arbor Day Tree Order Form to the City Secretary by February 10, 2010, together with your check. Checks should be made out to Bill Bounds Nursery. Sales tax is included.
