The event is being coordinated by ARC, a technology partner of Duchesne, and Fone4Schools, an organization that helps local schools raise money by converting donated electronics into funds for student programs.

The Fone4Schools program will donate the proceeds from recycling the donated electronics to the Duchesne Academy to support technology initiatives.

Fone4Schools is run by Strategic Mobile Group, LLC of Austin Texas and is a small, minority-owned business that provides logistics and asset recovery services to hundreds of schools, federal, state and local government agencies as well as corporate organizations nationwide.

The company was founded in 2011 to provide schools with advanced fundraising capabilities that help the environment and students. Fone4Schools follows the strictest environmental and security standards for donated electronics, as well as a "no-landfill" policy. ARC partners with Fone4Schools and Strategic Mobile Group to provide new technology solutions and services, including mobile devices and computers, for School Districts across the state.
