- I attended the Piney Point Town Hall meeting last night at which Mike Montgomery announced that sufficient pressure exists to allow residents to resume sprinkler system operation. Although some pumping station and other equipment repair work remains to be done, the MVWA is fully functional.
- The removal of trees from Center Point lines and rights of way by CP is ongoing. CP reports that in an emergency situation, they are not responsible for the collection, removal or moving of the resultant debris. Therefore, it must be the homeowner's responsibility to place all debris from their personal property at street side for the City to collect.
- CP will later establish a claims procedure for any damage to personal property as a result of the tree/branch pruning done within the easements.
- Debris removal by the City continues. We expect to complete the first pass of the entire City by this coming weekend.
- An additional contractor is in the city collecting bagged debris. They will be working in the City through Saturday 10/4.
