### **NEWS, ETC.**

- Mayor Bresenhan of Piney Point advises that our Center Point rep has declined to attend the Tuesday night town hall meeting at St. Francis Episcopal Day School (6:30 p.m.). I do not know the reasons. However, Mike Montgomery of MVWA will be there.
- Peggy Burck, Ed Neuhaus and I received about 15 visitors yesterday morning at City Hall and responded to 3 dozen emails and phone calls. No visitors this morning.

### **POWER**

- Good news: receiving many reports from citizens of power restoration.

### **DEBRIS**

- Crew #1 – Redeployed from Lindenwood/Shasta to N. Country Lane (1/2 day). Will move to west side of Kuhlman this afternoon and then back to N. Country Lane. When finished the crew will return to Lindenwood/Shasta.

- Crew #2 – Long Shadows, Roaring Brook, Smithdale. Slow going with lots of material.
- Crew #3 – Pifer and area.
- Crew #4 – Pine Grove, Sleepy Oaks and area. Will move on to the east side of Hedwig.
- Crew #5 – Bryn Mawr.
- Crew # 6 – Riverbend.

By Wednesday, crews will be in all areas not yet finished. By next weekend, it is our goal to complete the 1<sup>st</sup> pass through ALL neighborhoods.
