CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

This week's tips deal with preventing thefts from vehicles and thefts of vehicles.

NEVER leave an unattended vehicle unlocked even for a short time, regardless of where your vehicle is parked. It only takes a few seconds to lock the doors and set the alarm if your vehicle has one.

NEVER leave any keys including house keys in an unattended vehicle.

DO NOT leave valuables visible in the interior of an unattended vehicle. Lock them in the trunk, glove box or secure storage area or conceal them from view from outside of the vehicle.

When you leave your vehicle somewhere for service or when parking with a valet remove all house keys and other vehicle keys and only leave that vehicle's key. Also be sure to remove any documents that contain any personal information regarding your address or any credit/banking information from the vehicle.
