CRIME PREVENTION TIPS

As we get into the summer vacation season, please consider the following when leaving for vacation.

DO NOT leave valuables like jewelry inside your home when you are away. Take any jewelry that you are not taking with you to the bank and lock it in a safety deposit box.

Before leaving, take the time to check your home and be sure that all exterior doors and windows are locked and set your alarm system if you have one before leaving.

Put some interior lights on timers that will turn them on and off at different times to give the appearance that someone is home in the evening hours.

If vehicles will be left at the residence during your absence be sure that all valuables are removed from them and that they are locked and their alarm systems are set.

Notify the police department that you will be away so that your home can be placed on the house watch list. This will allow patrol officers to know that you are away so that a closer watch can be kept on your home.
